Project Update

Considerate Constructor Scheme and Morrison Construction Health and Safety Teams Visits are now complete, and the site has been issued with a "Blue Report", which will be a first for the site.

PJ Carey have been on site and both hard and soft ground works are progressing at a good rate, with lots of below ground rock being broken down and removed.

The Dunblane Memorial Tree will be relocated temporarily during these works, and replanted as part of the Landscaping Proposals once preparatory works have been completed.

Further landscaping works, in the form of planting trees to the south of the school, along the new pathway, has been completed

We appreciate your co-operation and patience during these works and we will continue to ensure any disruption is kept to a minimum

Three month look ahead ;

- Dig out for water attenuation tank, install tank.
- Lay aco channel drainage around the avenue.
- Grade out bicycle shelter area, shelters due this year.
- Tie in water outlet to main system in Soroba Road.
- Repair existing stone dyke, erect new dyke at Millar Road entrance.
- Works due for completion end Jan 2019.
